### Gourmet Delight at AC Schnitzer

But there is also much to admire in the sophisticated refinement of the restaurant, such as the original ceiling lights, the beautiful floor and the creative design of the bar.

While the customer enjoys an entrée of delicate chestnut soup, a few floors down work is already in progress on the interior conversion: his BMW is getting pedal covers, steering wheel and gear knob, and the i-Drive controller from the **AC Schnitzer range**.
